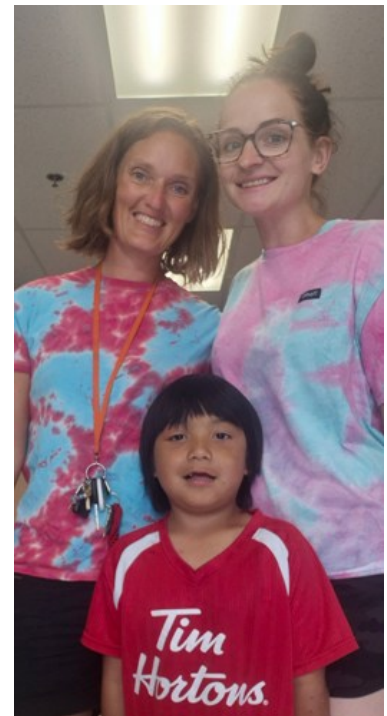

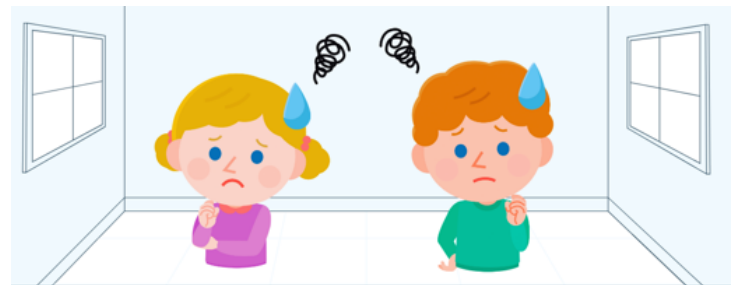
SCHOOL DELIVERY:
